Last night, on Thursday, October 5, 2017, around 10:00 p.m., Greater Sudbury Police responded to a motor vehicle collision on Notre Dame Avenue south of Lasalle Boulevard in Greater Sudbury.

Upon arrival it was discovered that a white Mitsubishi car had been travelling down Notre Dame Avenue towards downtown when it struck a large black dog that had escaped from its house and yard and ran across the road. The collision occurred near the entrance to Pioneer Manor.

The collision was heard by several witnesses who saw the motor vehicle stop and then accelerate away from the scene. The dog collapsed on the road and was safely removed by the witnesses and the dog’s owner. The dog succumbed to its injuries at the scene.
