

#### Calls for Service - Criminal vs. Non-Criminal


- Consistent 5 year trends in Sudbury
   Approximately 15% of calls are criminal in nature
   Approximately 85% of calls are non criminal in nature
- This trend is consistent across the province





### Calls for Service - Five Year Trend Analysis

- Calls for Service increased 1.4% in 2017 from 2016
- 5 year trend calls for service up 1.8%
- "Our Shared Commitment" policing model
- Referrals to other agencies/service providers for non police matters






#### Total Offences - Five Year Trend Analysis

 Numerous factors can contribute to fluctuations in crime statistics

- Enforcement driven crime
- Social and economic factors
- Crime prevention strategies
- Crime prevention through environmental design
- Heightened awareness
- Increased online reporting


#### **Total Offences by Year**






#### Total Offences and Clearance Rates

- 18.5% increase in criminal offences in 2017
- 87.7% of this increase due to property offences, not violent
- 5.6% decrease in clearance rates in 2017
- However, approximately 200 more offences cleared








#### Crime Category Offences


- Violent offences are up 6.3%
- Increase in sexual assault (increased reporting)
- Other Criminal Code offences are up 12.1%
- Proactive monitoring of local targets relating to child pornography
- Federal Statutes are down by 41.3%
- Decrease largely due to Found Property Drugs classification
- Property offences are up by 30.6%
- Theft Under and Fraud accounted for 63.3% of total property offences





#### Property Crime Offences


- Break and Enters are up by 26%
- Development of apartment building laundry room B-Es
- Theft of Motor Vehicles are up by 35.8%
- Trend present in same areas with high Theft from Vehicle offences
- Thefts are up by 36%
- Largely driven by Theft from Vehicles
- Theft from Vehicles up by 68.3%
- Frauds are up by 59%
- Largely related to Theft Under (Theft from Vehicle)
- Arsons are down by 31.8%





#### Crime Category Clearances


- Investigative standards and complexities
- Violent Crime clearance rates higher - offender often known to the victim
- Federal Statutes generally enforcement driven - high clearance rates
- Property Crimes challenging to solve due to scarcity of evidence, witnesses, forensics







- Overall increase of 6% in 2017
- Largely due to drug-impaired driving offences (9 more offences in 2017)
- Increased Enforcement
- Partnerships to reduce impaired driving
- MADD

- Last Drink Program

#### Crime Trends

- Overall crime has increased, largely in property offences
- Crime only represents small portion of policing services being delivered to the Community
- Investment in Community Safety and Well-Being

- Building & Understanding Resilience & Strength Together (B.U.R.S.T)
