CONSENT FOR MINORS

AND I CONSENT AND REQUEST, on behalf of myself and the Event Volunteer to participate as a volunteer with the Greater Sudbury Police Service as an Event Volunteer.

AND I UNDERSTAND, ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE THAT:

1. The Event Volunteer will be assigned duties as required at a Greater Sudbury Police Service event and will be supervised at all times. These duties could include, but are not limited to:
  - Event set-up
  - Registration Assistance
  - Assigned seating escort and assistance
  - Act as a Greater Sudbury Police Service mascot
  - Assist to transport items from area businesses to event
  - Assist to transport Greater Sudbury Police Service items and equipment to event
  - Assist to transport people to and from events
  - Event take-down
  - Assist to return any items outlined above
  - Participate in community events such as:
    - Pumpkin Patrol
    - Tim Horton's Ride & Bike
    - Santa Claus Parade
    - Special Olympics
  - Provide event assistance to other community organizations;
2. The activities of my minor child may involve physical exertion and there exists risk, including the remote possibility of injury, including abnormal blood pressure, fainting, and disorders of the heart rhythm and, in very rare circumstances, heart attack or even death as well as cuts, infections, bruises and broken bones and knowing these risks, it is my desire to have my minor child participate;
3. Choosing to have my minor child participate in the Event Volunteer Program brings with it the assumption by me and by my minor child of the above stated potential RISKS and I ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY to instruct my minor child about these RISKS and the choices available to him

or her;

4. While my minor child is participating, my minor child should use caution and wear appropriate clothing and protective equipment which will be supplied by the Greater Sudbury Police Service Event Supervisor as required; and
5. During my minor child's participation, it is my minor child's complete right and responsibility to decrease or stop participating at any time my minor child believes it is unsafe to continue doing so and that it is my minor child's obligation to inform the Greater Sudbury Police Service Event Supervisor or designate of my minor child's concerns or symptoms;
6. My minor child is free to withdraw and I am free to withdraw my minor child from the Event Volunteer Program at any time;
7. I will voluntarily withdraw my minor child from the Event Volunteer Program if my minor child begins to experience any signs of lightheadedness, fainting, chest discomfort, leg cramps, nausea or other ailments affecting my minor child's health; and
8. I shall inform the Entity and Group Leader of any allergy or medical condition or allergies and supply him/her with any medication or devices and instructions associated with the medications or devices in the event my minor child requires treatment;
9. The Greater Sudbury Police Service may, but is not required to, use the Event Participant's name, likeness, statements or other identifying information, including in photographs, video and recordings, for the purposes of publicizing and promoting GSPS events, worldwide, in perpetuity, including use in any media now known or hereinafter devised throughout the universe, including but not limited to, print on the World-Wide-Web, and furthermore, I agree that I will not be compensated for such use.

AND I WARRANT that my minor child is physically, mentally and emotionally fit to participate in the Program.

ALL IN CONSIDERATION OF the acceptance of my minor child, the Event Volunteer, in the Event Volunteer Program and by signing this Informed Consent, Release and Waiver, I, for myself and my minor child, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, release, waive and forever discharge the Greater Sudbury Police Service, the City of Greater Sudbury and all of their elected and non-elected officials, employees, agents, servants, volunteers and sponsors, and successors and assigns of and from all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, actions and causes of action, whether in law or equity, in respect of death, injury, loss or damage to my person or property however caused, arising by reason of my minor child's participation in this Event Volunteer Program, or in any activities associated with this Event Volunteer Program, notwithstanding that same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the Greater Sudbury Police Service, the City of Greater Sudbury, its elected or non-elected officials, employees, agents or servants.
